Who can apply: Any AHSA Association member (junior or senior) who is pursuing a college education following high school graduation and who has not passed their 21st birthday as of January 1, 2022. Complete guidelines found in application.

Who can apply: Members of American Rambouillet Junior Association who are high school graduating seniors accepted to an accredited Trade School, Junior College, University or State College, or students currently enrolled in one of those institutions, who raise and/or have raised Rambouillets.

American Sheep Industry - \$3,000

“Sheep Heritage Foundation Scholarship”

Who can apply: Graduate students (MS or PhD) involved in sheep and/or wool research in such areas as animal science, agriculture economics or veterinary medicine with proof of graduate school acceptance.

American Dorper Sheep Breeders’ Society – \$1,000 minimum

Who can apply: Graduating seniors, homeschool graduate or current college student (up to age 21) who are active, paid junior members of the American Dorper Sheep Breeders’ Society member for 3 consecutive years immediately prior to the application and who are intending to use the money toward future education or certification in the agricultural field.

California Wool Growers Association - \$1,000

Who can apply: Enrolled college students pursuing an academic program with an interest and/or emphasis in the California sheep industry. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior and/or student enrolled in a California Community College, 4 year University within California, California State University, or University of California, and have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA.

Livestock Judging Scholarship - Varies Show Team Scholarship -

Who can apply: Students with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA. Students must maintain eligibility to compete in any national or regional livestock judging competition with EWC and the Junior College, and must abide by Judging Coaches Association abide by National Show Ring code of ethics.

Who can apply: High school seniors or current college students who are Iowa residents.

Who can apply: College or graduate students or high school seniors who are or will be attending a college or university. They or family member must be a member of KHSI and involved with the Katahdin sheep industry for at least a year.

Make it With Wool - Four totaling over \$6,000

Who can apply: Awards available for entrants ages 13 years & older. Must enter at district and/or state level with home-constructed garment of at least 60 percent wool. Applicant must model garment. Complete rules available from State Director, National Coordinator, and online. Please note: Scholarships are only awarded at the national level.

Maryland Sheep Breeders Association & Maryland Sheep & Wool Festival - \$1,000

Who can apply: Students who have been accepted or are applying for continuing education at a college or university, technical school, or vocational school. All academic majors will be considered, but priority will be given to agricultural or agriculture related majors (such as food science, veterinarian, ag. teaching, etc.). Preference will be given to those applicants who are members or whose families are members of the Maryland Sheep Breeders Association.

Who can apply: High school seniors, college or graduate students who are residents of Missouri and attending a college or university (in-state or out-of-state) of their choice, or out-of-state students attending a Missouri college or university and who have been involved in 4-H, FFA, or the sheep industry.

Who can apply: Junior Montadale members either entering or enrolled in a four-year college or university, two-year college or junior college, or vocation-technical school, who has been a member of the Association for a minimum of five years.

"Tracy Repasky Memorial Scholarship Awards"

Who can apply: Any student completing at least half of their college or technical school studies the year in which the application is made or be enrolled in graduate school, and are current or previous member of the Continental Dorset Club Youth Enrollment Program or current lifetime members of the Continental Dorset Club.

Who can apply: Any member of NTSRI who is who is seeking post-secondary education in the fall of 2022. Students must begin college in the fall of 2022 to receive the award. The applicant or their parent must be a current member of NTSRI, and have at least 2 sheep registered with the organization the past two years.

Who can apply: Youth members in good standing, Junior or Regular, of NCWGA headed for college after graduating from an accredited or chartered school who have raised natural colored sheep.

Who can apply: A student completing half of his or her college studies the year in which the application is made or be enrolled in graduate school; residents of the New England States and Eastern New York State where the New England Sheep and Wool Growers have an appointed director or to students who themselves or families are members of NES&WGA.

Who can apply: Any New Hampshire resident who has completed at least one year at a post-secondary educational institution and has an affiliation with sheep through 4-H, FFA, Young Farmers, New Hampshire Sheep and Wool Growers' Association, or is majoring in a field that will benefit the sheep industry.

Who can apply: High school seniors graduating in 2022 or college students age 25 or younger, who must be enrolled in UW-Madison Agriculture Short Course, technical school, community college or an accredited 4-year college in the fall. Parents or applicant must have been members of the Wisconsin Sheep Breeders Coop for a minimum of two consecutive years including the year of application.
