Dear Sheep Breeder,

Plans have been finalized for this year's Illini Bred Ewe Sale and you are invited to consign. The Illini Bred Ewe & Ewe Lamb Sale is one of America's oldest and strongest bred ewe sales in the country. It has a strong tradition of offering high quality breeding ewes. The sale will be at the beautiful **Weitendorf Agricultural Education Center** of Joliet Junior College, just off the junction of I-80 and I-55. Both sellers and buyers are very pleased with the facilities. The Illini All-Breeds Spring Sale / Illini Dorset Sale will also be at this facility in April and we have had overwhelming positive responses.

This letter contains the rules and conditions that the sale will be held under. Also included is a sheet listing the 2018 General Sales Information that applies to all Banner Sale Management Sales. Please carefully read all information.

**Entry Deadline:** October 10, 2018

**Entry Fee:** \$30.00 per head. All entry fees are due at the time entries are made and are nonrefundable.

**Commission:** 10% of the gross price on all sheep

**Equipment:** We will also accept consignments of good serviceable sheep equipment. No entry fee is charged on equipment and commission of 20% will be charged on all equipment sold. We are expecting shears, trimming stands, sheep equipment, blankets, etc. Please consign only usable sheep related equipment. This is not the place to clean out your old shed.

**NOTE SCHEDULE FOR EQUIPMENT:** All equipment must be checked in with the clerks. Equipment that is checked in Friday evening will sell in the first round on Saturday. All equipment must be checked in before 9:00 a.m. Saturday. Any equipment brought in later will be turned away. The equipment auction will begin at 1:00 p.m. and the Bred Ewe Sale will begin promptly at 2:00 p.m. Any equipment not sold before the sheep will sell in a second round of equipment auction that will begin immediately following the Bred Ewe Sale.

**Breed Fees:** The American Corriedale Association, Inc. requires us to deduct 1% from Corriedale consignors. These fees are deducted from the consignor settlements.

**Breeds:** The Illini Bred Ewe Sale is open to all breeds of sheep and to breeders from all parts of the country. We are expecting entries from the following breeds: Cheviots, Columbias, Corriedales, Dorsers, Dorsets, Hampshires, Katahdins, Lincolns, Montadales, Natural Colored, Oxfords, Polypays, Rambouillets, Shropshires, Southdowns, Suffolks, Tunis, and Wether Sires & Dams (Both registered and crossbred). All breeds welcome.

**Divisions:** Breeding Sheep will have classes for all breeds entered.  
Wether Sires / Dams will have classes for Suffolks, Hampshires, All-Other Breeds, Crossbred & Unregistered.

**Sale Classes:** Yearling Ewes (born 9/1/16 – 8/31/17)  
Brood Ewes (born 9/1/13 – 8/31/16)  
Senior Ewe Lambs (born 9/1/17 – 12/31/17)  
Junior Ewe Lambs (born 1/1/18 – 8/31/18)  
Baby Lambs (Rams & Ewes) (born 9/1/18 & after) Baby lamb class is the only classification where rams are allowed in the sale.

**Breeding Certificates:** All ewes yearlings and older must sell as bred. Service Sire information and breeding certificates must accompany ewe registration papers at check in. Age limit on brood ewes is 5 years old. All ewes must have sound udders.

**Registration Papers:** All animals in all classes except Crossbred & Unregistered must have a valid registration paper. All lambs sold at the mother's side must have either a registration paper of a completed application for registry. All registration papers are to be turned in to Banner Sale Management at check-in. These registration papers will be transferred and forwarded to the buyers. Cost of transfers will be deducted from consignor settlements.

**Health Papers:** All animals that sell at the Illini Bred Ewe Sale must be in compliance with Illinois and Federal health / scrapie requirements. For any questions please call 866-USDA-TAG (866/873-2824) or Illinois State Veterinarian Office at 217/782-4944. You must have an individual currently valid health paper issued within 30 days of the sale for every animal you sell. Veterinarians require that you provide 2 copies of the health paper for each sheep entered. A Federal Scrapie ID Tag must be in each animal's ear. This applies to all animals in all classes.

The following information must be legibly written or typed on all health papers:

- 1) Owner or consignor name & address
- 2) Species & purpose of movement
- 3) Private flock tag number **AND**
- 4) Federal Scrapie ID number (must include premise ID and individual tag number)
- 5) Age, sex, and breed of each animal
- 6) Signature and printed name, address and phone number of accredited veterinarian.

**Out of State Sheep:** All out of state sheep entering Illinois are required to obtain a permit number to enter the state. Your veterinarian can obtain the permit number by calling the Illinois Department of Agriculture at 217/782-4944. This permit number must be written on health papers.

**Recording of Tag Numbers on Health Papers:** Please ask your veterinarian to be sure to include **both the private flock number and complete scrapie tag number** on the health papers. Sheep can and often do lose tags. If this happens, the health paper will still match the sheep and many problems are avoided.

It is your responsibility to provide the sale manager clear and legible copies of health papers. You will need two copies of the health paper for each animal in your consignment. (3 sheep = 6 copies) Banner Sale Management suggests that you provide a copy of the above health paper requirements to your veterinarian to ensure that you are in compliance with health regulations.

**Sale Catalogs:** A complete Sale Catalog will appear in the October / November Issue of THE BANNER SHEEP MAGAZINE as well as be posted on the web at [www.bannersheepmagazine.com](http://www.bannersheepmagazine.com). We also direct mail to a large list of potential buyers. If you know of anyone who would like to receive a catalog, please provide us with their full name and address or refer them to the website. The entry fee provides you a space to write about your entries and pedigrees, 50 words maximum. Any over that will be edited. With this information, we can do a much better job of selling your sheep. "Information Sale Day" sells few sheep!

**Online Photo Album:** Banner Sale Management is excited to announce that consignors to the 2018 Illini Bred Ewe Sale will be able to take advantage of a complimentary new Banner feature – an online photo album of entries on our Facebook page! We believe a photo album is a great supplement to the sale catalog. We invite you to send one photo of each animal using this link: <https://form.jotform.com/BannerPublications/ILBE-photos>. The due date is tentatively scheduled for September 18. When sending your photos, the animal's lot number is required. Once available, please use the catalog to identify your lot number(s). Photos submitted via email cannot be accepted, so please use the form link above. Photos will be posted to Facebook.com/Banner Sheep Magazine, and the description will include your name, flock name, the lot number and ear tag. More details can be found in the form's instructions once the catalog is available.


**Judging Contest:** There will again be a judging contest for all 4-H and FFA members at 10:30 a.m. Both team and individual participation is welcomed. Winning 4-H and FFA teams will receive plaques. The two high-placing 4-H and the two high-placing FFA members will each receive buying credit to be used toward the purchase of any sheep or equipment in the sale. Sign up will take place the morning of the contest.
