This letter contains the rules and conditions that the sale will be held under. Also included is a sheet listing the 2019 General Sales Information that applies to Banner Sale Management Sales in general. Please carefully read this information.

Show & Sale Date: October 18 & 19, 2019

Location: Dutchess County Fairgrounds, 6550 Spring Brook Ave, Rhinebeck, NY 12572

Schedule: Show – Friday, October 18 – 1:00 p.m.
Sale – Saturday, October 19 – 10:00 a.m.

Sheep Judge: Ed Julian, Rootstown, Ohio

Auctioneer: Tyler Lobdell, Illinois

Entry Deadline: Mailed entries must be postmarked by September 1. Online and faxed entries are due September 5 (*Please get your entries in on time!*) to be included in the sale catalog published in the September issue of The Banner.

Entry Fee: \$30.00 per head. All entry fees are due at the time entries are made and are nonrefundable.

Commission: 10% of the gross price.

Sponsorship: The sponsors of the sale, Dutchess County Sheep and Wool Growers Association, receive an additional 2 % of the sale gross on all sheep sold in the sale.

Breed Fees: The American Corriedale Association, Inc. requires us to deduct 1% of the gross on Corriedales sold.

Breeds: The New York Bred Ewe, Ewe Lamb & Ram Sale is open to all breeds of sheep and to breeders from all parts of the country. We are expecting entries from the following breeds: Bluefaced Leicesters, Border Cheviots, Border Leicesters (White & Natural Colored), Columbias, Corriedales, Cotswolds, Hampshires, Horned Dorsets, Icelandics, Lincolns (White & Natural Colored), Merinos, Natural Coloreds, North Country Cheviots, Oxfords, Polled Dorsets, Polypays, Rambouillets, Romneys (White & Black), Shetlands, Shropshires, Southdowns, Suffolks, Tunis, Crossbred Wool Breeds, Crossbred Wether Dams.

Sheep Sale Classes:

Yearlings Ewes (9/1/17 – 8/31/18)

Bred Ewes up to four years of age (9/1/15 – 8/31/17)

Fall Ewe Lambs (born 9/1/18 – 12/31/18)

Spring Ewe Lambs (born 1/1/19 & after)

Rams: 1 entry per consignment. To sell a ram you must enter 2 ewes of the same breed. Only yearling rams or ram lambs may be sold.

Used Equipment Consignment Auction: 20% Commission is charged.

Equipment will begin selling 30 minutes following the sheep sale.

Equipment Check-in: Equipment check-in will be from 10:00 a.m. to 6 p.m. Friday.

Equipment Drop-off: All equipment may be put on display following check-in, beginning 10 a.m. Friday morning until 6 p.m. in a designated area in the sale pavilion. All equipment must be in place by 9:30 a.m. Saturday.

Fleece Length: All animals should be properly presented for show. Southdowns follow American Southdown Breeders Association rules to be slick shorn.

Sheep Registration Papers: All animals in all registered classes **must** have a valid registration paper. All registration papers are to be turned in to Banner Sale Management at check-in. These registration papers will be transferred and forwarded to the buyers. Cost of transfers will be deducted from consignor settlements.

Bred & Exposed Ewes: ALL EWES, YEARLINGS AND OLDER, MUST SELL AS EXPOSED OR BRED. Service sire information and breeding certificates must accompany ewe registration papers at check in.

Sheep Health Papers: You must have an individual currently valid health paper for every animal you sell issued within 30 days of the sale. A Federal Scrapie ID Tag must be in each animal's ear. This applies to all animals in all classes. The following information must be legibly written or typed on all health papers:

- 1) Owner or consignor name & address
- 2) Species & purpose of movement
- 3) Private flock tag number **and**
- 4) Federal scrapie ID number (must be complete)
- 5) Age, sex, and breed of each animal
- 6) Signature and printed name, address and phone number of accredited veterinarian.

As a consignor, please take the responsibility to ensure that all of the above information is complete and legible. It is your responsibility to provide the sale manager clear and legible copies. You will need two copies for each animal in your consignment. (3 animals = 6 copies)

Sale Catalogs: A complete Sale Catalog will appear in the September Issue of THE BANNER SHEEP MAGAZINE as well as be posted on the web at www.bannersheepmagazine.com. A link will also be made to the New York Festival website. As in previous years, we also direct mail to a large list of potential buyers. If you know of anyone who would like to receive a catalog, please refer them to our website or provide us with their full name and address. The entry fee provides you a space to write about your entries and pedigrees, 50 words maximum. Any over that will be edited. With this information, we can do a much better job of selling your sheep. "Information Sale Day" sells few sheep!

Online Photo Album: Consignors to the sale will be able to take advantage of a complimentary Banner feature, an online photo album of entries on our Facebook page. We believe a photo album is a great supplement to the sale catalog. We invite you to send one photo of each animal using this link: <https://form.jotform.com/BannerPublications/NewYork> The due date is October 13. When sending your photos, the animal's lot number is required. Once available, please use the catalog to identify your lot number(s). Photos will be posted to Facebook.com/Banner Sheep Magazine. The photo's description will include your name, flock name, the lot number and ear tag. More details can be found in the form's instructions once the catalog is available.


Festival Admission: There is an admission fee to enter the grounds Saturday and Sunday. Coupons will be included in the sale catalog for Saturday admission.
