Dear Suffolk Breeder,

Preparations are rapidly being made for the 2021 Stars of Louisville Suffolk Show & Sale and you are invited to consign. We are excited that the Superbowl of Sheep Shows gets to happen once again. This letter contains the rules and conditions that the sale will be held under. Also included is a sheet listing the 2021 General Sales Information that applies to all Banner Sale Management Sales. Please carefully read all information.

Show & Sale Date: Saturday, November 13, 2021

SALE CATALOGS will be complete by OCTOBER 20. Entries must be received on time to be listed in the catalog!

Entry Fee: \$30 per head. All entry fees are due at the time entries are made and are nonrefundable.

Commission: BSMS commission is 10% of the gross sale price.

Sale Sponsor: The United Suffolk Sheep Association as the sale sponsor requires us to deduct an additional 1% of the gross on all sheep sold to support association activities. The North American International Livestock Exposition requires that all sales deduct an additional 3% for their operation fees.

Sale Classes: Yearling Ewes (born 9/1/19 - 8/31/20), Bred Brood Ewes up to 4 years of age (born 9/1/17 - 8/31/19), Fall Ewe Lambs (born 9/1/20 - 12/31/20), January Ewe Lambs, All Slick Sheared Ewe Lambs, February Ewe Lambs, March & After Ewe Lambs.

All entries will be under the guidance of the North American International Livestock Exhibitor requirements. **Sheep entered in the North American International Suffolk Sale need not be shown in the Open Show;** however, you must make an entry at the North American to ensure yourself pen space if not entered at NAILE. Consignors exhibiting Suffolks in the Open Show, when indicating the number of pens you need, please include sale sheep. Service Sire Information and breeding certificates must accompany registration papers at check in for all ewes yearlings and older. Age limit on brood ewes is 4 years old. All ewes must have sound udders.

Health Paper Notice: Health regulations are subject to change at any time so please check with your local veterinarian or the Kentucky State Veterinarian Office for current requirements. All health papers are checked on arrival to NAILE and again prior to the sale. Consignors are responsible for all costs incurred to make health papers valid and compliant with Kentucky Health Regulations.

Call Kentucky State Veterinarian Office (502-573-0282) before shipping from the following states: California and Michigan.

Health Papers: All animals that sell must be in compliance with Kentucky and Federal health / scrapie requirements. For any questions please call Kentucky State Veterinarian Office at 502-573-0282 or go to their website, www.kyagr.com. There is also a link to this site from the NAILE website, www.livestockexpo.org. Please note that according to Kentucky State Regulations, the entry requirements for sale sheep differs slightly from sheep entered only in the show. We recommend that you have a separate health paper for the sale sheep. See information on Entry Permit.

ENTRY PERMIT: An entry permit must be obtained for out of state sheep entering Kentucky for the sale. Your veterinarian must obtain this permit by calling the Kentucky State Veterinarian Office (502-573-0282), Ryan Corlis, Commissioner. This permit number must be on the health paper.

Health Papers for Sheep entered in the Sale must have a permit number.

You must have 2 copies of an individual official health certificate issued within 30 days of the sale for every animal you sell. All sheep will be subject to reexamination prior to the sale. If signs of dermatitis, fungus, ringworm, footrot, soremouth, or caseouslymphadentis are visible, animals will immediately be removed from NAILE show grounds.

A Federal Scrapie ID Tag must be in each animal's ear. This applies to all animals in all classes.

The following information must be legibly written or typed on all health papers:

- 1) Owner or consignor name & address
- 2) Species & purpose of movement
- 3) Private flock tag number
- 4) Federal Scrapie ID number (must include premise ID and individual tag number)
- 5) Age, sex, and breed of each animal
- 6) Permit number for sheep from states other than Kentucky
- 7) Signature and printed name, address and phone number of accredited veterinarian.

As a consignor, please take the responsibility to ensure that all of the above information is complete and legible. It is your responsibility to provide the sale manager clear and legible copies. You will need 2 copies of an individual official health certificate for each animal in your consignment. (3 sheep = 6 copies) Banner Sale Management suggests that you provide a copy of the above information to your veterinarian to be sure that you are in compliance with the above listed regulations.

Show Rights: All sheep sold are eligible for release immediately after the sale. You may however retain show rights of your sale sheep through the open show on Tuesday, November 16, 2021. If you choose to exercise this option, it must be CLEARLY stated with your entries and declared at sale check in so that it can be announced prior to the animal's sale.

DNA Test Results: The United Suffolk Sheep Association as sponsors of the sale require that full Codon 171 (Scrapie Susceptibility) and Spider Syndrome genotype information be disclosed by show day. All consignors must adhere to the Disclosure Requirements as set forth by the United Suffolk Sheep Association. This information will be printed on the sale orders. Space is available on the entry forms if this information is known at the time entries are made. We suggest that all consignors post DNA results on stall cards at the pens so that this information can be made available to prospective buyers. To assist all consignors, blank stall cards are available at check-in. Neither Banner Sale Management nor sale sponsors shall assume any liability, legal or otherwise, expressed or implied as it relates to this information.

Sale Catalogs: A complete Sale Catalog will appear in the October/November Issue of *The Banner Sheep Magazine* as well as be posted on the web at www.bannersheepmagazine.com and https://suffolks.org, and shared via other wide-reaching digital marketing campaigns. We also direct mail to a large list of potential buyers. If you know of anyone who would like to receive a catalog, please provide us with their full name and address or refer them to our website. The entry fee provides you a space to write about your entries and pedigrees, 50 words maximum. Any over that will be edited. With this information, we can do a much better job of selling your sheep. "Information Sale Day" sells few sheep!

All entry fees are due at the time entries are made and are nonrefundable. Neither emailed entries nor telephone entries will be accepted. Please use only one method of submission and do not send duplicate entries. Banner Sale Management takes no responsibility for entries not received and reserves the right to refuse any entries submitted.
