HEALTH PAPERS: Will be written at the sale. Your local or state veterinarian should be able to update you concerning the health requirements for sheep entering from your state. All sheep sold must be in compliance with current Federal Scrapie Regulations. The sale veterinarian will prepare standard, interstate health papers for transportation between states, but it is the buyer's responsibility to be cognizant of and adhere to the entrace requirements of his own state. INFORMATION RETAINMENT COMPLIANCE FEE (IRCF): There will be an IRCF of \$10 per head sold on all animals added to the buyer's settlement at this sale. This applies to all animals sold through the sale. Institutions may pay by requisition. Foreign buyers must pay in U.S. funds. Registration papers will not be transferred to the new owner until paid in full.
