SHOW & SALE ORDER: The show and sale order is by breed in the same order as cataloged. Show order within each breed is yearling ewes, brood ewes, senior ewe lambs and junior ewe lambs. Sale order within each breed is determined by show placings.

INFORMATION RETAINMENT COMPLIANCE FEE (IRCF): There will be an IRCF of \$10 per head sold on all animals added to the buyer's settlement at this sale. Banner Sale Management maintains records on all animals sold through the sale ring for a minimum of five years to be in compliance with regulations as set forth by the United States Department of Agriculture and the Packers and Stockyards Administration.

MAIL BIDS: If you cannot attend the sale in person, a number of individuals will be able to handle your bids. These include the Sale Manager, Greg Deakin, the auctioneers, ringmen and judges. All mail bids must have pre-approval by Sale Management prior to the start of the sale. All animals not paid for sale day will be handled as a mail bid. You can have the agent handling your mail bid pay your balance on sale day with your check, cash or credit card. All mail bids not paid for sale day will be assessed a 5% fee. The above Buyer Premium applies to all mail bids.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TERMS: Cash. All purchases are to be settled with the clerks immediately following the sale and before the sheep are removed from the premises unless arrangements and approval have been made with the Sale Manager prior to the sale. The auctioneer's decision is final on any disputed bids. All animals are at purchaser's risk as soon as sold. Sheep purchased on order must be paid within five (5) days of the sale. A 10% handling fee will be added to all mail bids not paid within five days of the sale. A 20% surcharge will be assessed to any insufficient funds check issues. Buyer shall be responsible for any and all costs of collection, including attorney's fees. Institutions may pay by requisition. Foreign buyers must pay in U.S. funds. Registration papers will not be transferred to the new owner until paid in full.

REGISTRATION & HEALTH: All animals are registered. Health papers will be handed out sale day to the new owner upon complete payment of the sheep. Transfer of registration papers will be handled by Banner Sale Management Service after the sale.

ENTRY SUBSTITUTIONS: A bar beneath the number painted on the animal's back designates that it is a substitute entry, meaning the information about the animal is different than designated in the catalog. Check with the consignor for complete pedigree information.

2 - Ewes sold as bred ewes that are not in fact bred, shall be adjusted by one of the three following seller's options:

- replace the original ewe with another bred ewe or with a ewe with lamb(s) at side to the satisfaction of the buyer, or
- the buyer to keep the original ewe with the seller to provide a compensatory lamb or lambs to the satisfaction of the buyer, or
- the seller to refund a compensatory 20 percent of the original purchase price for the lack of lamb crop.
